MORE POLICE COVERAGE FOR FLANDERS - From dusk to dawn, there will be 2 sector cars in our area. One will patrol east of 105, and one will patrol west of 105. In addition, every hour the CRU (Community Response Team) is staffed, it will be assigned to Flanders, Riverside, and Northampton. That's an additional 75+ hours of coverage we lacked before. Also the CRU is ticketing cars at overcrowded homes and checking the quality of life issues. Thanks to Chief Pearce and the Police Department. Many residents spoke at a board meeting about safety issues in the area, or wrote and called about the issue. Thanks for standing up for Flanders.
