**TROOPER BARRACKS TO CLOSE** - Councilwoman Christine Scalera has written to the head of the NYS Troopers to protest the closing of the trooper barracks in Riverside on Rte 104 (Riverleigh Avenue). The closing will seriously affect the Riverside community near the traffic circle. Riverside is to be redeveloped and improved, and the loss of police presence is a huge problem.
