NEIGHBORHOOD ALERT - Home invasion on Monday, Nov. 9! A residence on Flanders Road near Wood Road Trail was invaded in the wee hours by 3 armed men. They escaped and are sought by police. Keep your doors and windows locked. Keep outside lights on. Be a good neighbor: call police if anything odd is going on nearby.

TROOPER BARRACKS TO CLOSE - As of now, the barracks will close to the public shortly. Cars will still patrol the South and North Forks, but there will be fewer troopers stationed here on Rte. 104/Riverleigh Ave. Due to transfers of newer troopers, and retirement of senior troopers, we will be shorted manpower. If you need police help, phone 727-2727. Sgt. Dolazel, spokesman for the barracks, said state police are available for proactive policing. Write or call Governor Cuomo (who controls the funding for the state police). Call the Town Hall to let the Supervisor at (631) 283-6055 and the Council at (631) 287-5745 know how you feel. Call Senator LaValle at (631) 473-1461 and Assemblyman Thiele at (631) 537-2583. We need a barracks with full staffing and cars on patrol.

FALL LEAF PROGRAM - The Fall Leaf Program will begin on Monday, November 30. You can put leaves out starting Nov. 16. Leaves must be in biodegradable bags at the edge of your property. If you are 73 and older, loose leaves will be picked up IF you have made arrangements with the Highway Department before Nov. 30. Call the Leaf Hotline at 631-702-2585. No brush or branches will be accepted. If you have brush/branches, call 631-283-5210. If you have a contractor, vouchers will be issued starting Nov.16. Call 631-702-2585 for details.
